About this Workshop

This workshop brings together Australian and international experts in high-pressure (HP) research to share the latest scientific advances, discuss experimental and computational methodologies, and strengthen national and international collaborations. The programme combines focused technical sessions, open panel discussions, and informal time to encourage genuine exchange of ideas.

The first two days are hosted at the Australian National University (ANU) in Canberra. On Wednesday morning, participants travel together to Kioloa Coastal Campus on the NSW South Coast — a relaxed environment ideal for deeper discussions, beach walks, and collaborative thinking.

- **Talks & speakers:** Invited speakers only for formal talks. ECR and student participation is via poster session and the School Day.
- **Monday School Day:** Participants will be assigned to Group A or B in advance. Software (GSAS-II / Dioptas) should be installed on your laptop before Wednesday — instructions will be sent by 20 November.
- **Poster sessions:** Duration ~60 min each (Tuesday and Wednesday evenings at ANU).
- **Kioloa transport** Please let the organising committee know if you need a spot on the bus or if you are planning to self-drive.
- **Kioloa accommodation:** Shared rooms. Bedding, towels, and basic toiletries provided. Bring sunscreen, walking shoes, swimmers, and some warmer layers for evenings.
